Dr Narendra, Pondicherry, helping to develop a Sanskrit syllabus with published books suitable for non-Indian children also from 2008 to the present.

Public Talks. When asked public talks have been given, usually in the form of interactive workshops on the following topics: 'Language'; 'Vedic Mathematics'; 'Practical Geeta'; 'Yoga sutras' and 'Why and How Sanskrit'. The last topics have been given more frequently in India mostly in various Schools and Universities in Bangalore, in Kerala, Mumbai and in Kurukshetra.

Involvement with John Scottus since its inception in 1986.

I was Assistant to the Headmaster for a number of years from 1992 and again from 2017 and became Vice-Principal until 2008.

2008/2009 Academic year plus summer holidays in India (mostly Veda Vijnana Gurukulam) to get a handle on Sanskrit. In 2009 I asked to step down as vice-principal so I could dedicate more time developing a Sanskrit Course for children, which is still my main interest.

5th and 6th year class-teacher since 2007. With this age group I have been at least once in Peru, China, Ecuador, India (but as a Wellbeing trip), Vietnam, Venezuela, Italy, France, Holland, Austria, Andorra, Tanzania, England and Portugal. Most of these trips were in the summer holidays from end of May to July 1, 2, 4 or 6 weeks long. Winter sport trips during the Christmas Holidays or the spring midterm. They usually involved some Social work and (extreme) sports, such as high altitude mountain climbing, white-water rafting, skiing, zip-lining, via ferrate and parachute jumping.

2016 to the present running a Junior Certificate Shortcourse in Wellbeing for 12-15 year-olds. This course is based on Ayurveda and Yoga-sutras, broadly speaking the former for physical and the latter for mental Wellbeing. Final approval pending (but fully endorsed in a few months). Research done in particular to help teenagers in Ireland to improve their wellbeing or reduce or stop self-harming. Research for this course with the support of lecturers and professors from Prashanti Kutiram SVYAASA University in Bengaluru (2016-2018) and Ayurvedic University in Jamnagar (2019).
