26	Summary of the Event	The Department of Computer Applications – BCA initiated the event from the Coding Club, "CODEZENITH 2026". The inter-college hackathon event was on the 16th and 17th of April 2026. This landmark event was organized in professional association with Cascade Labs and represented the culmination of two months of rigorous strategic planning. As the department's first major foray into hosting an inter-college technical competition of this scale, the primary objective was to bridge the gap between classroom theory and industrial application. By challenging students to solve real-world problems under pressure, the event sought to sharpen their programming logic, collaborative skills, and professional presentation abilities. The event began on the morning of April 16th at Building No. 17, DSCASC, with a formal inauguration ceremony that set an inspiring tone for the participants. The event was honored by the presence of key academic leaders, including Dr. Aruna Devi, Head of the BCA Department, Deputy Director Dr. Kumudavalli, and IQAC Coordinator Dr. Gurunath. Representing the industry perspective, Mr. Ashwin Kripal and Mr. Althaf, the Founder and Co-Founder of Cascade Labs respectively, interacted directly with the students, offering unique insights into the current tech landscape. A total of 19 teams, comprising 57 students from various institutions across Bangalore, registered for the challenge. After the unveiling of five distinct problem statements, teams spent the remainder of the first day in deep brainstorming sessions, working to align their creative visions with the technical requirements provided by the industry partners. The momentum carried into the second day, which was dedicated to the intensive development and final evaluation of prototypes. Throughout April 17th, the venue transformed into a hub of technical innovation as teams refined their code and prepared their pitches. Each group was given the opportunity to demonstrate their solution before a distinguished panel of judges, followed by a rigorous Q&A session designed to test their logical depth and technical adaptability. This interactive phase allowed students to receive direct, actionable feedback from experts, a rare opportunity in a standard academic setting. At 4.00 PM the valedictory session was organized. After a thorough assessment of all 19 prototypes, the judges identified the winners and runners-up, who were awarded attractive cash prizes with mementos for their exceptional work. Beyond the winners, every participant was recognized with a certificate to honor their dedication and active contribution to the event's success. Ultimately, CodeZenith 2026 stood as a testament to the department's commitment to fostering a culture of innovation. The successful execution of the event, which was planned meticulously over the preceding 60 days, has established a new benchmark for technical excellence within the institution.

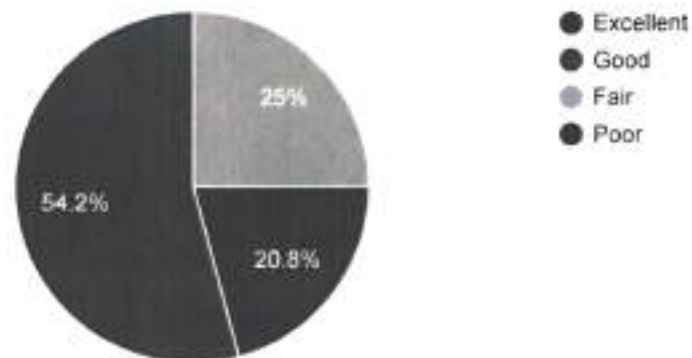

1. How would you rate the overall experience of the hackathon? Copy

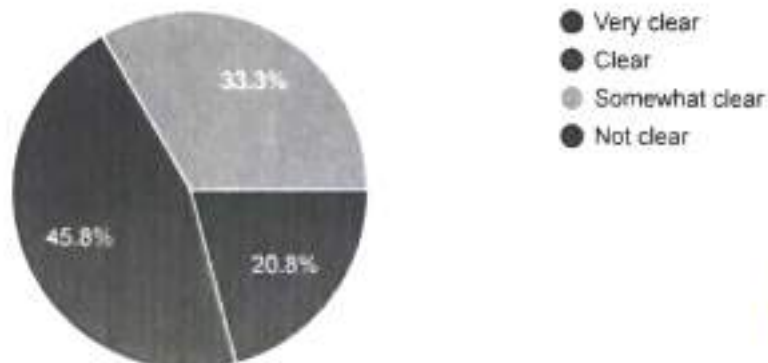

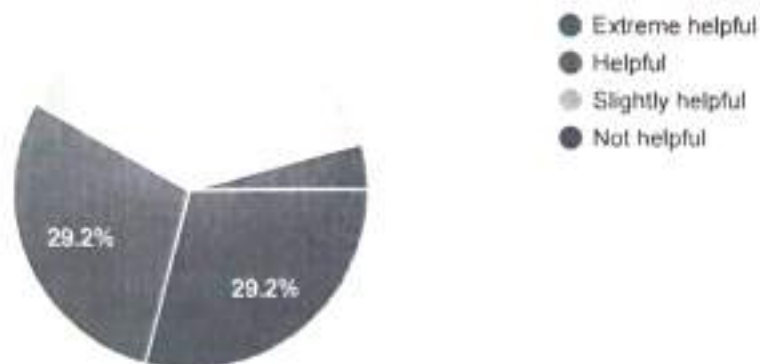
**3. How clear were the hackathon problem statements?** Copy

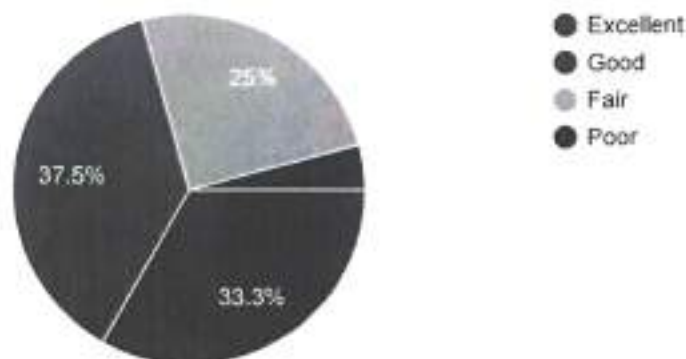


4. How helpful were the mentors during the event? Copy

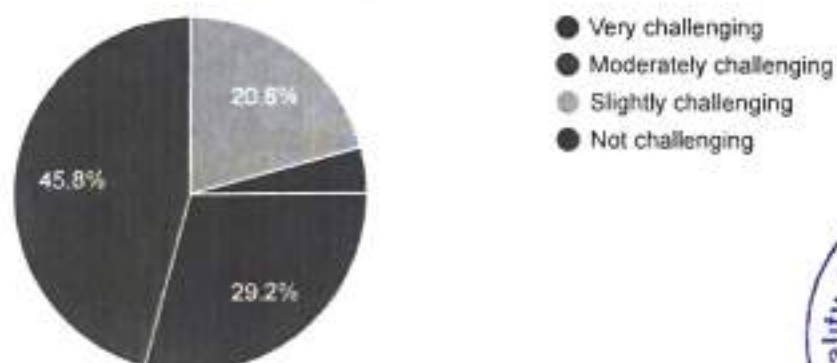
