The session also highlighted the impact of capital structure on shareholder wealth, financial flexibility, and corporate performance. 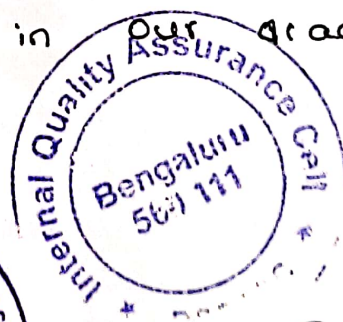
