Event Highlights:

- 1. Participants should report at the venue (Seminar Hall, Building no 17, DSCASC) at 9.30 A M on 15th October 2025
- 2. The event will unfold as per the following schedule:

Level 1	Registration and knowledge-sharing session led by a domain expert, followed by the unveiling of the problem statements	15th October, 11:00 AM	~1-2 hrs
Level 2	Code at your comfort	15th October, 2:00 PM	20 hrs
Level 3	Model demonstration and final presentation	16th October, 11:00 AM (Report at 10.30 AM)	As per team presentation slots

- 3. Trophies and Cash prize for Winners and Runners. The best two teams will get an internship opportunity.
- 4. Participants will benefit from the mentorship of industry leaders and gain networking opportunities with peers.
- 5. Eligible participants include students from BCA/BSc/MCA/BE CSE (and allied branches)

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Each team must consist of exactly two participants.
- 2. Participant fee is ₹400 per team, payable during online registration.
- 3.A maximum of one team per course from each institution may register.
- 4. The use of open-source libraries, APIs, and datasets is strongly encouraged.
