Guidelines for Writing Research Paper

Note: Only full papers (in the below format) with conference fee paid will be considered for issue of conference certificate and publishing in the ISBN conference proceedings.

General Guidelines:

For your article to be published in the proceedings or journal, all authors must closely adhere to the standards and formatting instructions for paper submission.

1. Submissions need to be original and should not be already published or presented elsewhere.
2. Kindly ensure that each paper submitted is distinct and original.
3. Post submission, no requests for revisions to the paper title, abstract, authors, track, and actual text shall be taken into consideration. As a general guideline:
 - i. The paper should have an abstract not exceeding a maximum of 300 words.
 - ii. Maximum of 6 keywords should be provided.
 - iii. The paper should not exceed a maximum of 4000 words, including all tables, figures, references, and appendices.
 - iv. The paper should follow Times New Roman 12-point font, and 1.5 line spacing and Margins should be one inch on all four sides.
 - v. First Page: Title, Author(s) Name(s), Affiliation(s), with contact number and email id.
 - vi. Second Page: Title (Times New Roman size 14, All Caps), Abstract (between 200-300 words),
 - vii. Keywords, followed by the main text (refer to contents below). Sub-headings should be in Times New Roman, Size 12 and Bold.
 - viii. All pages should be numbered.
 - ix. The paper should be submitted in the conference submission system as a single Word file. The paper should follow the APA (American Psychological Association) referencing style.
4. Only submissions in English-language will be considered.
