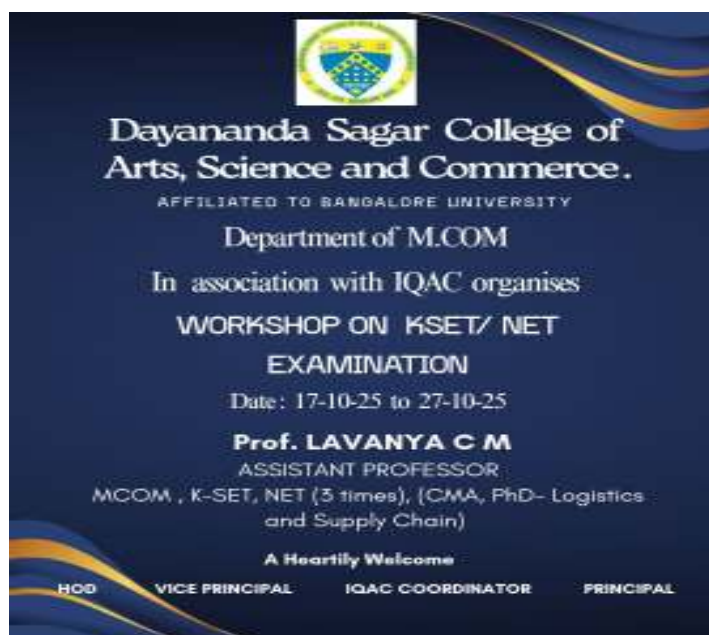

The Department of M.Com successfully organised a creative and inspiring Collage Making Competition on 12th November 2025, centered on the theme “Milestones of Mahatma Gandhi During the Freedom Struggle.” The event aimed to blend artistic expression with historical understanding, encouraging students to revisit the major turning points shaped by Gandhiji’s leadership in India’s fight for independence. Participants showcased their creativity by portraying key moments that transformed the nation. Various milestones highlighted in the collages included the Champaran Satyagraha (1917)—Gandhiji’s first major victory using non-violent resistance; the Non-Cooperation Movement (1920), which united millions across India in peaceful protest; and the Salt March/Dandi March (1930), a powerful symbol of civil disobedience that shook the foundations of British authority. Students also depicted the Quit India Movement (1942), one of the most decisive calls for complete independence, along with significant ideals promoted by Gandhi such as truth, non-violence, swaraj, self-reliance, and communal harmony. Through colours, cut-outs, and thoughtful arrangements, the participants reflected how these milestones not only challenged colonial rule but also awakened a collective national spirit. The competition served as a meaningful educational activity, motivating students to understand the deeper impact of Gandhian philosophy on India’s freedom trajectory. The event concluded with appreciation for the students’ artistic efforts and insightful representation of history. 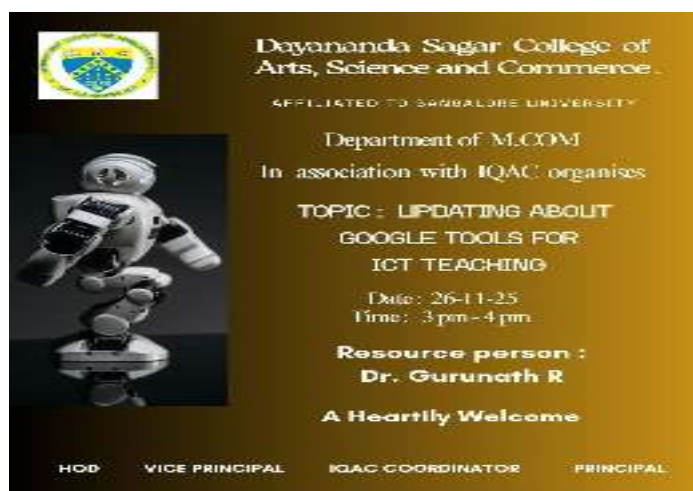

12. Seminar – 2 Psychology of Digital Fatigue and Cognitive Overload among Youths

The seminar began with a welcome address followed by an introduction of the guest speaker.

Mr. Shiva Kumarappa started the session by explaining **what digital fatigue is**, describing it as a state of mental exhaustion caused by continuous online engagement. He highlighted how prolonged usage of smartphones, laptops, and social media platforms affects attention span, emotional balance, and overall mental wellness.

He then discussed **cognitive overload**, explaining how constant notifications, multitasking, and information overflow decrease productivity and hamper memory retention. The speaker shared several real-life examples and research findings to help students connect the topic with their personal experiences.

Key points covered in the session:

Increased digital dependency post-COVID has intensified mental fatigue among youth.

Online classes, social media pressures, and entertainment apps contribute significantly to cognitive load. Symptoms include irritability, reduced concentration, headaches, sleep disturbances, and emotional exhaustion. Social comparison through digital platforms affects self-esteem and leads to anxiety. Excessive multitasking lowers efficiency and increases psychological strain. The speaker also engaged the audience through interactive questions, encouraging them to share their own digital habits and challenges.

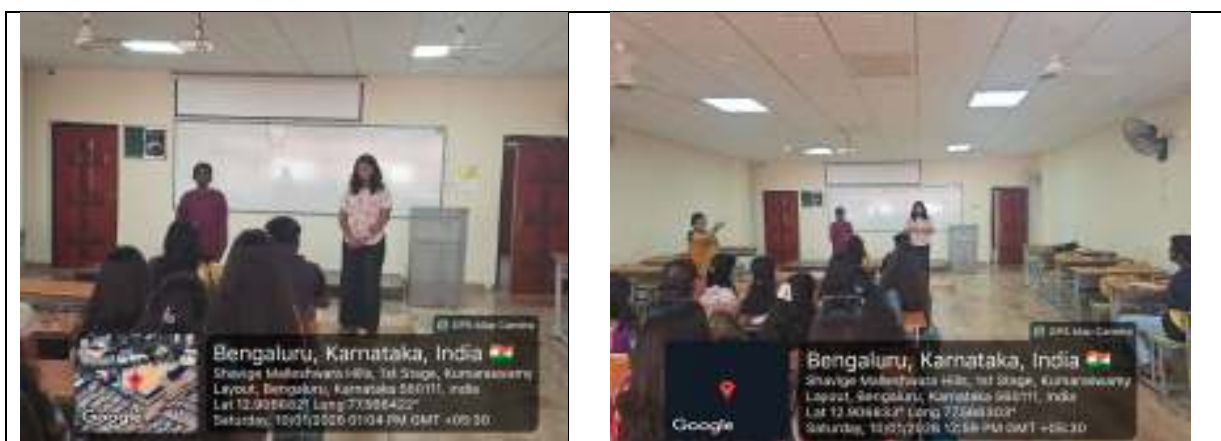
