Internal assessment policy

Department of M.Com

The Department of M.Com Conducts Internal assessment test for all semesters as per Bangalore University Guidelines. To ensure that the students are involved in continuous learning, 2 tests are conducted based on Units covered i.e every 2 chapters a test is conducted for 40 marks, the average of both the test is reduced to 20 marks as per University requirement. The students who score less in 1st test are listed as slow learners and high scores are identified to help slow learner in informal groups. On the other hand, the advanced learners are also extended with extra help by providing any text book specially from faculty. The slow learners are instructed to attend remedial classes just before the main exams and remedial assignments are written by students who perform low in IA tests. Students with Low attendance are also made to attend remedial classes for the topics they might have missed and assignments are submitted as per respective subject faculty. Final marks are assessed on the basis of criteria of Bangalore university.

Guidelines from Bangalore University:

In case of theory papers the various components of internal assessment will be as follows: a) Assignment – 5 Marks b) Attendance – 5 marks (75% = 80% - 1 Mark, 80% > 85% - 2 Marks, 85% > 90% - 3 Marks, 90% to 95% - 4 Marks, 95% = 5 Marks) c) Internal Test – 20 Marks (The test shall be for 11/2 - hour duration carrying 40 marks. The marks scored by the candidate shall be later reduced to 20 marks).
