



Executive Summary



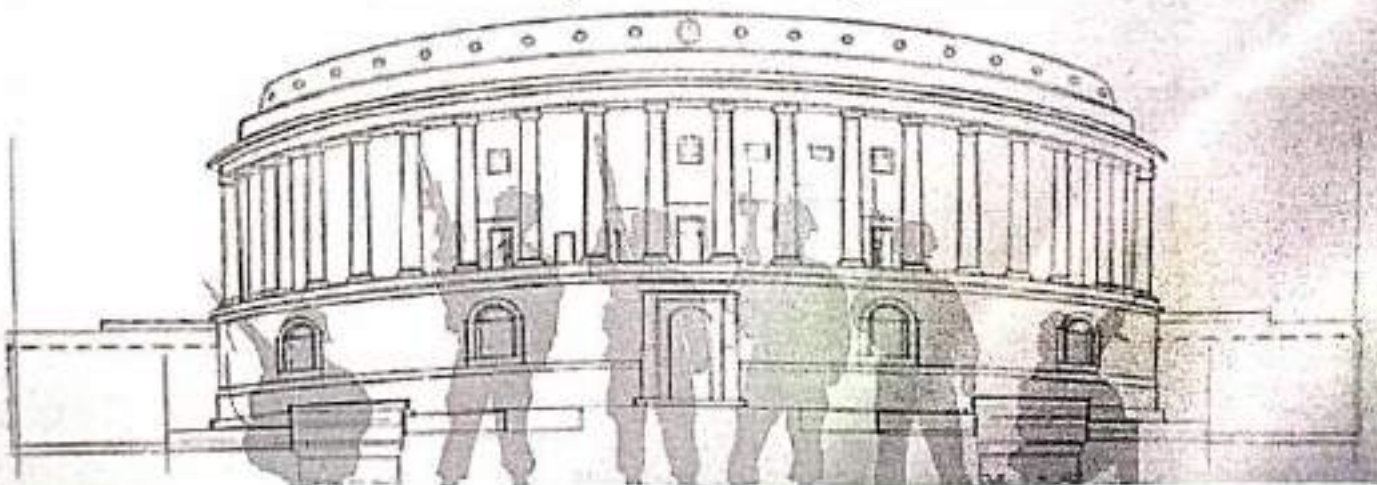
