The National Digital Library (NDL) and National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) deliver millions of open-access materials, from multidisciplinary e-books to video lectures on engineering, humanities, and sciences. Complementing these are dedicated sections for E-Question Papers, E-Books, and E-Rare Books—digitized gems like historical manuscripts and out-of-print classics—alongside curated Useful URL Links to platforms like JSTOR and Google Scholar.

The physical space buzzes with intellectual energy, as captured in snapshots of collaborative corners where students pore over open textbooks amid towering wooden shelves stocked with management volumes, reference tomes, and rare editions on global finance and human resource development.
