Dr. S. Ramkumar currently serves as an Associate Professor at Christ University, Bangalore. With 13 years of teaching experience and 12 years dedicated to research, Dr. Ramkumar has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals and conferences. His primary research interests include Bio-Signal Processing, Artificial Intelligence, Human-Computer Interaction, Brain Computer Interfaces, and Machine Vision. 



#### Satisfaction with One Day Seminar




# Question 2: How effective was the Resource Person (Dr. S.Ram Kumar) in delivering the content and facilitating the session regarding research article writing?

Effectiveness of Dr. S. Ram Kumar




Question 3: How effective was the Resource Person (Dr. R Gobinath) in delivering the content and facilitating the session regarding research article writing?

Effectiveness of Dr. R. Gobinath




# Question 4: Was the Workshop theme relevant to your interests and research field?

### Relevance of Workshop Theme to Interests/Research Field




### Question 7: The experience regarding the Workshop technical support and facilities

#### Workshop Technical Support and Facilities




# Question 8: How effectively did the program meet your expectations regarding skills development?

#### **Program Meeting Expectations for Skills Development**




Question 9: How would you rate your overall experience at the Workshop?
