The districts of the Western Ghats and the southern districts of the state have popular eco-tourism locations including Kudremukh, Madikeri and Agumbe. The ruins of the Vijayanagar empire at Hampi and Monolithic temples of Pattadakal are on the list of UNESCO'S world heritage sites. The cave temples at Badami and the rock-cut temples at Aihole are also popular tourist destinations. The Hoysala temples at Belur and Halebidu which were built with chlorite schist are proposed UNESCO world heritage sites. The monolith of Gomateshwara at Shravanabelogola is the tallest sculpted monolith in the world. 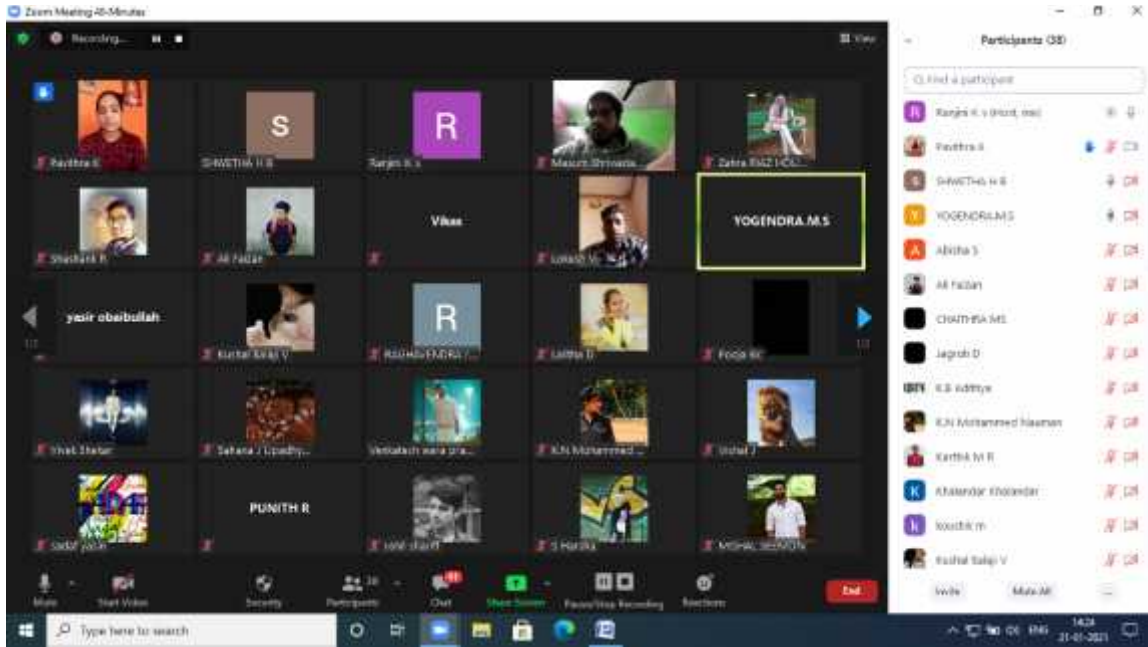

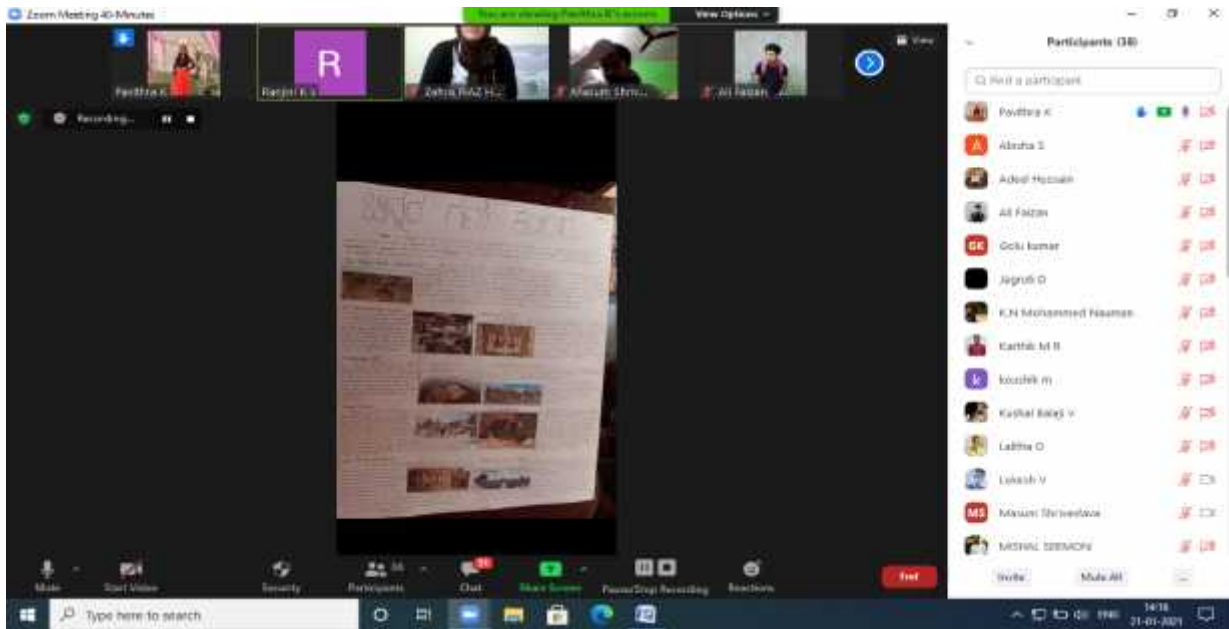

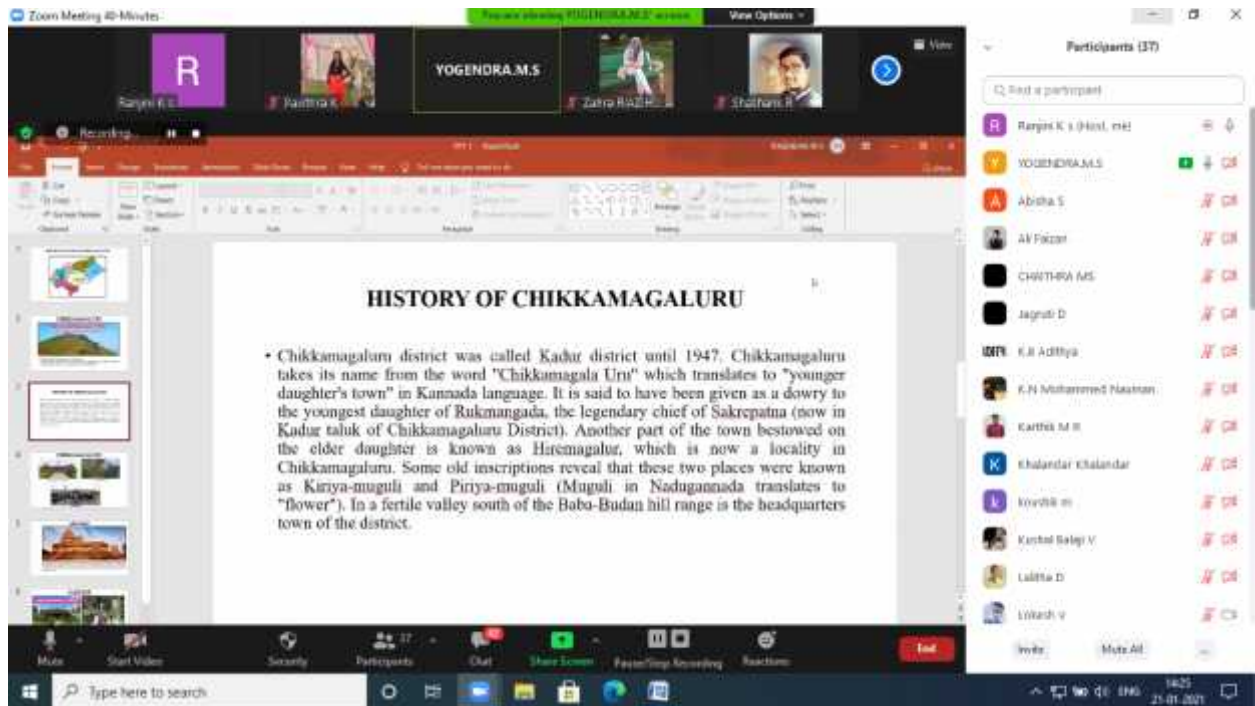


Photo-5 Chikkamagaluru Famous Places

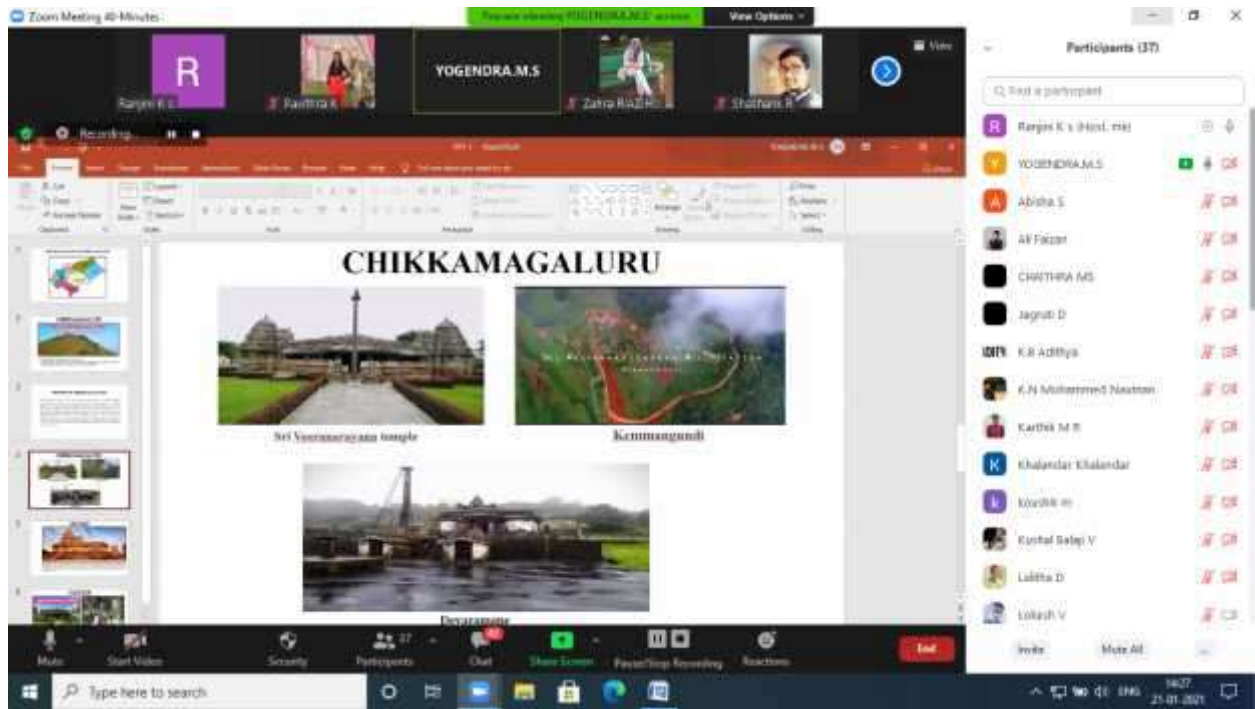


Photo-6. Historical places of Chikkamagalore

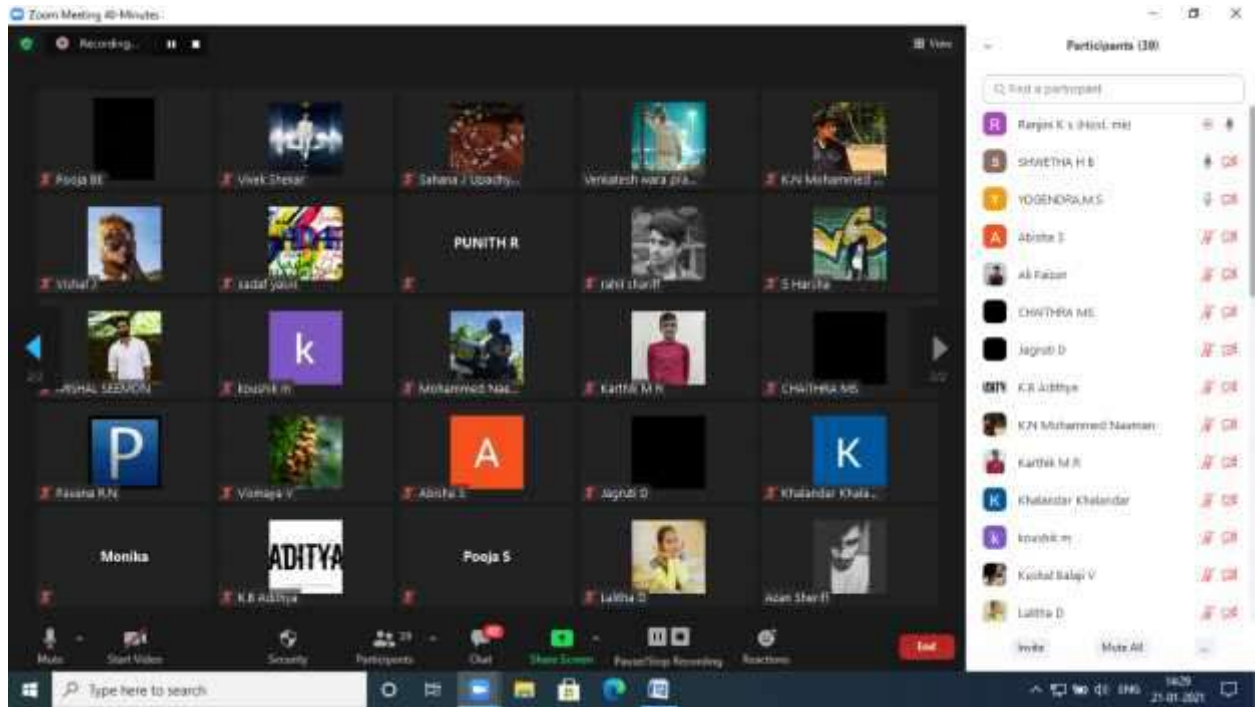
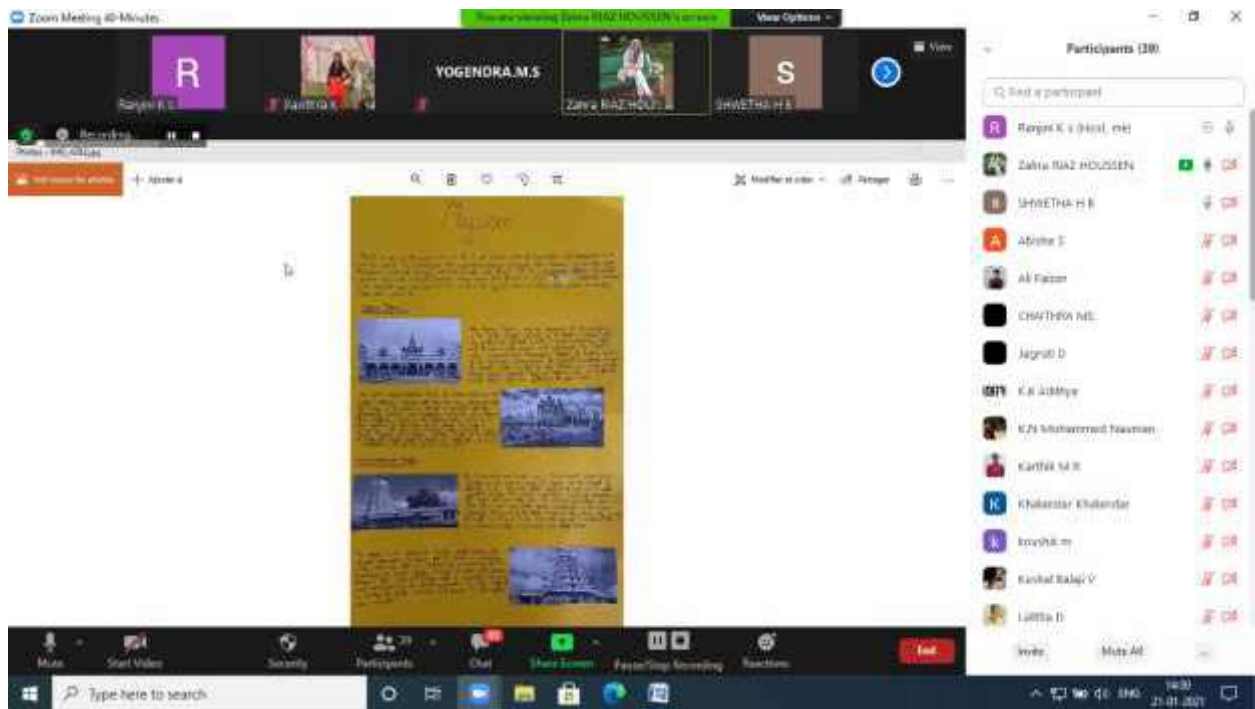

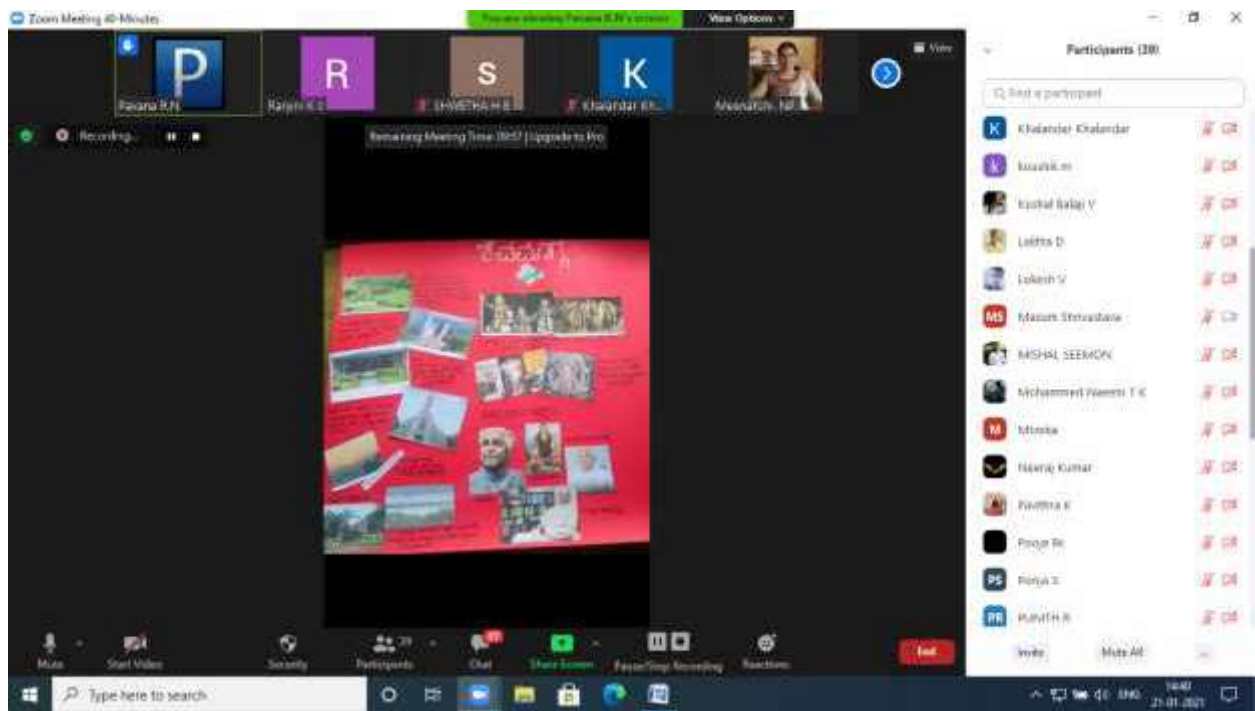


Photo-10. History of Shivamogga

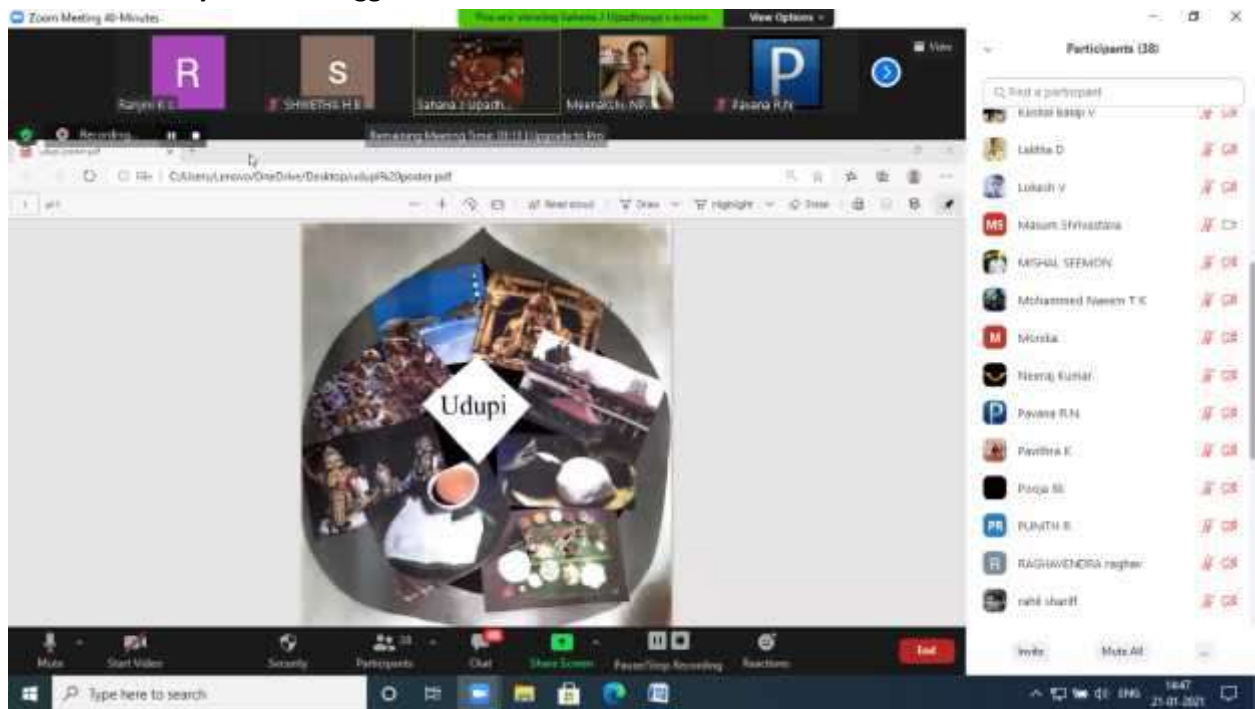


Photo-11. Famous Places of Udupi

HISTORY OF CHIKKAMAGALURU

- Chikkamagaluru district was called Kadur district until 1947. Chikkamagaluru takes its name from the word "Chikkamagala Uru" which translates to "younger daughter's town" in Kannada language. It is said to have been given as a dowry to the youngest daughter of Rukmangada, the legendary chief of Sakrepatna (now in Kadur taluk of Chikkamagaluru District). Another part of the town bestowed on the elder daughter is known as Hiremagalur, which is now a locality in Chikkamagaluru. Some old inscriptions reveal that these two places were known as Kiriya-muguli and Piriya-muguli (Muguli in Nadugannada translates to "flower"). In a fertile valley south of the Baba-Budan hill range is the headquarters town of the district.

The temple was constructed in the 12th century by the anonymous Amrutheshwara Devasthana. During the rule of Veera Ballala II, the Hoysala King. The era of the Hoysalas also coincided with the spread of the granite design philosophy which can be seen across the state of Karnataka. One of Karnataka's most famous sculptors was Mallikarjuna, and it is believed that he started his artistic career at Amrutheshwara, engraving the beginning of a golden era in the art.

History of Kallihalli Falls According to popular local legend, the son of the Kallihalli Falls was a pilgrim son of the holy land Agastya, who chanted upon the falls during his wanderings and stayed here for years a few months. The waterfall also houses the 'Sivalakshmeswara Temple, which was built during the Vijayanagara era.






