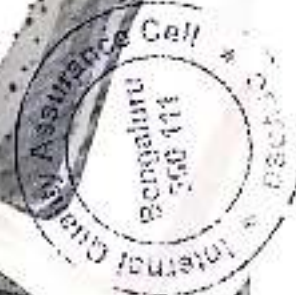

A highly respected scholar and mentor, Dr. Lokesh has passionately taught core subjects like **Educational Psychology** and **Philosophy of Education** at both B.Ed. and M.Ed. levels.
